I/We understand that Government through Trading Corporation of Bangladesh hereinafter Referred to as the “Buyer” has invited Tender for import of 30,00,000 (±5%) Liter of Refined Soybean as per following terms & conditions:-

**1.0 TENDER INSTRUCTIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITH, WITHOUT FAIL:**

- 1.1 The Tender shall be accompanied by, cash receipt showing payment of the cost of Tender documents and Tender Security amounting **USD 89,400.00 (US Dollar Eighty Nine Thousand Four Hundred) or BDT 76,00,000.00 (BDT Seventy Six Lac) only** in the form of Pay Order/Bank Draft/Bank Guarantee with provision of clause of this Tender. Bank Guarantee must be endorsed by any local scheduled bank on **BDT 300 Non-Judicial Stamp** which will be liable to settle any claim without any question whatsoever. Pay Order/Bank Draft/ must be issued from any scheduled bank of Bangladesh. Tender without Tender Security shall not be considered for acceptance.
- 1.2 Specification wise price is to be quoted in the Tender schedule.
- 1.3 Each tender shall be submitted in two separate sealed cover one written in “**Original**” and other written in “**Duplicate**” which are superscripted with tender numbers and name of them addressed to the Chairman, Trading Corporation of Bangladesh. It shall be dropped personally/by representative in the tender box kept in front of TCB’s reception (2<sup>nd</sup> floor) TCB Bhaban, 1, Kawran Bazar. **No tender will be opened without duplicate copy.**
- 1.4 Tender shall remain valid for acceptance **360 (Three Hundred Sixty)** hours from the time & date on which they are opened. The validity of tender may be extended if so required by the Buyer as approved by Government. If any Tender is withdrawn before the expiry of minimum **360 (Three Hundred Sixty)** Hours as aforesaid, the tenderer will be debarment listed and Tender Security shall be forfeited.
- 1.5 Each Tender shall strictly comply with all requirements laid down in this form and no space be kept blank.
- 1.6 The Buyer reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders without mentioning any reason thereof or reserves the right to purchase any quantity more or less than those quoted for.
- 1.7 The Tender is open to all subject to stipulated terms and conditions. There are two options to submit Tender as a seller. (a) Foreign company will submit Tender through local agent & (b) Local company will submit Tender mentioning their foreign principal.
- 1.7.1 **Option (i):** In case any tender is submitted by a local agent, the tenderer will have to
  - (a) Submit formal agency agreement signed between the principal and the local agent under their official seals along with tender so that tenderer can deal with the tendered quantity.  
The local agent shall have to submit Principal’s
  - (b) Certification of Incorporation/Trade License
  - (c) Membership Certificate of Chamber of Commerce.
  - (d) Financial Solvency Certificate from any scheduled bank indicating minimum **USD 2.2 (US Dollar Two Point Two Million)** deposit or credit limit to them
  - (e) Export Registration Certificate
  - (f) Documents in support of shipment of human food items (Chick Pea, Crude Degummed Soyabean Oil (CDSO) Refined Soybean Oil, Crude Palm Olein, Refined Palm Olein, Refined Sugar, Rice, Wheat, Red Lentil etc.).If the local agent is to sign contract on behalf of the principal, he must produce letter of authorization before signing of the contract.

- 1.7.2 The local agent shall have to submit
- (a) Trade license
  - (b) TIN certificate
  - (c) VAT registration certificate
  - (d) Import registration certificate
  - (e) Indenting certificate (If any)
  - (f) Solvency certificate from any scheduled Bank of Bangladesh issued not earlier than one month before opening of tender.
- In case a local agent submits the tender on behalf of its Seller, the local agent will require submitting
- (g) A proof of authorization from the principal to submit the tender on its behalf.
- 1.7.3 **Option (ii):** In case any tender is submitted by any Bangladeshi company as seller, then the tenderer will have to submit
- (a) Formal agreement signed with his foreign principal under their official seals along with tender so that at the time of evaluation buyer can ensure that tenderer will supply the goods as per terms of schedule and contract. The seller shall have to submit his,
  - (b) Certification of Incorporation/Trade License
  - (c) Membership Certificate of Chamber of Commerce
  - (d) Financial Solvency Certificate from any scheduled bank indicating minimum **BDT 18,70,00,000 (Eighteen Crore Seventy Lac)** deposit or credit limit to them
  - (e) Import Registration Certificate
  - (f) Documents in support of import of human food items (Chick Pea ,Crude Degummed Soyabean Oil (CDSO) Refined Soybean Oil, Crude Palm Olein, Refined Palm Olein, Refined Sugar, Rice, Wheat, Red Lentil etc) .
- 1.7.4 The tenderer also will have to submit of principal's (a) Certification of Incorporation/Trade License (b) Membership Certificate of Chamber of Commerce (c) Financial Solvency Certificate from any scheduled bank indicating minimum **USD 2.2 (US Dollar Two Point Two Million)** deposit or credit limit to them (d) Export Registration Certificate (e) Documents in support of shipment of human food items (Chick Pea ,Crude Degummed Soyabean Oil (CDSO) Refined Soybean Oil, Crude Palm Olein, Refined Palm Olein, Refined Sugar, Rice, Wheat, Red Lentil etc) .
- 1.8 Source of supply, port of shipment, name and address of the seller along with certificate regarding specification, quality of goods and commitment of supply against this tender shall be mentioned in this tender form clearly. A Proforma Invoice from the Beneficiary (Principal/Seller) on their letter head in original or in fax followed by original letter head duly signed and sealed indicating quantity tendered, shipment schedule agreed, price and specification of the tendered goods shall be submitted along with the tender as a proof of positive line up of supply without which the tender shall not be considered.
- 1.9 The tenderer or bidder must quote price (in US Dollar) for **Refined Soybean Oil per Ltr** on CFR(C) Chattogram (Previous name Chittagong) liner term by sea showing break up of FOB price, freight and commission separately. The tender must be prepared in English.
- 1.10 The tender must be firm and final; validity of the tender must be quoted clearly.
- 1.11 Tenders received late and or incomplete will not be accepted.
- 1.12 The local agent's commission, if any, should be mentioned separately and clearly and will be paid in Bangladesh currency on satisfactory performance of the contract at the rate of exchange prevailing on the date of negotiation of documents.
- 1.13 Goods tender must not originate from Israel. The goods must not also be shipped on a vessel flying the flag of Israel.
- 1.14 In case, the tenderers/bidders submit fake documents along with their tender and furnish incorrect/false/misleading information in their tender, the tenderer will be debarment listed and Tender Security shall be forfeited.
- 1.15 If any tenderers/bidder makes any written complaint against the decision taken on a particular case of Tender import and if, such complaint does not stand on proper scrutiny, the case is to be put up to the appropriate authority through Tender committee stating all details. In such case, the Tender committee may recommend punitive measure for debarment listing and Tender Security shall be forfeited.
- 1.16 In case, of local agent/(Principal/Seller) fails to receipt of Notification of Award (NOA)/order or fails to submit of Performance Security the buyer shall have right to forfeit the Tender Security. After signing the contract if the local agent/(Principal/Seller) fails to supply the goods the buyer shall have forfeit the Performance Security and both the original seller and his local agent will be debarment listed and Tender Security shall be forfeited.
- 1.17 No Debarment listed company(s) or their associates/sister concerns or in any way connected with the debarment listed company shall not be eligible to participate in this Tender.

**6.0 PERIOD OF DELIVERY:**

- 6.1 Refined Soybean Oil being an essential commodity, timely shipment and arrival of goods are the essence of the contract shipment of contracted Refined Soybean Oil is to be effected as per following schedule.

(a) Entire quantity of 30,00,000 (± 5%) Liter Refined Soybean Oil will be shipped within **15-10-2021**.

- 6.2 After opening Letter of Credit by Buyer in favor of Seller, if there is any amendment needed by Seller, it is to be informed to Buyer within 03 (Three) days and Buyer will take necessary steps as per contract. If there is no correspondence within 03 (Three) days then Buyer will consider L/C to be functional and this period (Maximum 03 days) will not be deducted from period of shipment/ delivery. I.e. latest date of shipment maximum **18-10-2021**.

11.0 **PRESHIPMENT INSPECTION (CHECK OF QUALITY, QUANTITY, WEIGHT AND CONDITIONS):**

11.1 Apart from the seller's certificate guaranteeing quality and weight of the goods delivered, the quality, specification, quantity/weight (Gross and Net.) packing and marking of the goods shall be corroborated by certificate of pre-shipment inspections. The pre-shipment inspection certificate should indicate detailed specification gross and net. Weight of goods shipped. Pre-shipment inspection and loading supervision will be done in presence of seller's representative and certificate issued by the inspection agent nominated by the buyer. - b) In the event of non-acceptance of an inspection order, without good and sufficient reasons, the Buyer shall reserve the right to place of a fresh order with any other inspection agency and the inspector will be liable to compensate the purchaser for the loss which may result there from.
- (c) The quality inspection shall include physical, chemical, laboratory tests whenever necessary. In case of goods test/laboratory test shall be carried out on reasonable number of samples depending on the quantity of supply. In case of food items or any items test shall be conform to International standards and/or specified in the contract. Test reports and certificates shall be submitted to the purchaser immediately after the test is performed.
- (d) State inspection and testing of the entire stores with regard to performance, quality, quantity & workmanship shall have to be done as per requirement of the relevant specifications.
- (e) Inspection of packing & supervision of weighing or quantity checks as well as supervision of loading of stores shall have to be done as per terms of the contract for the stores inspected.
- (f) Inspection & supervision of loading of stores shall have to be carried out by the inspectors well in time so as to ensure deliveries within the delivery period in this contract.
- (g) Inspection of the stores after the expiry of the delivery period shall not be carried out unless expressly authorized the purchaser.
- (h) Inspection certificate shall have to be issued by the inspectors or their accredited representatives for each consignment/item inspected and accepted.
- (i) Liaison shall have to be maintained by the Inspectors with the Buyer.
- (j) Partial shipment may be allowed by the Buyer where demanded by the Seller's to their convenience. A clause will, however, be incorporated in supply/purchase contract that the supplier/manufactures abroad shall provide to the inspectors or to their authorized representatives all facilities for carrying out inspection & witnessing tests as provided in the specification governing such suppliers or in conformity with the normal trade practices.
- (k) The inspection agent shall entirely responsible for successful execution of the order/contract in all respects and in accordance with terms and conditions specified therein. The terms and conditions of Tender instructions to the renderers and specification will constitute as an integral part of the contract.

In spite of this clear provision in the purchase order if the supplier/manufacturers abroad do not provide such facilities, the inspectors shall have to inform the purchaser and after obtaining his permission, they shall have to make their own arrangement for carrying out inspection or test as stipulated in the supply/purchase contract involved. In that case, the actual expenses on that account will be reimbursable to the inspectors on production of original documents and will be recovered by the purchaser from the suppliers concerned. Inspectors will, however, have to make efforts to reduce such expenses to the barest minimum.

11.10 **SELLER'S RESPONSIBILITY DURING INSPECTION:**

i) **PACKING AND MARKING:**

- a) Responsibility for proper packing: The supplier will be held responsible for the stores being sufficiently and properly marked for transport by rail, road and sea, so as to ensure their being free from loss or injury on arrival at their destination. The packing of the stores shall be done by and at the expense of the supplier.
- b) If the stores are not packed and marked in accordance with the instruction or in case where the packing materials are delivered separately and they are not in accordance with those instructions are not marked according to them consignment are liable to be rejected by the Inspector whose decision as to the sufficiency or otherwise of compliance with the instruction shall be final. Re-packing, if required by the inspector before onward dispatch shall be carried out by the supplier within a reasonable time of the deed and therefore, be carryout the Inspector at the cost of the supplier

ii) **DELIVERY:**

- a) The supplier shall allow all reasonable facilities to the Inspector including free and full access to his works and all records having a bearing on the progress of the deliveries against the contract.
- b) Notification by the supplier: Suppliers will notify the PSI Company/Inspector about the readiness of the concerned stores for inspection and test 10 (Ten) days in advance. In any case the notified date of readiness should be well in advance so that inspections and tests are completed before the date of shipment. The corporation is responsible for immediately notifying the Supplier if readiness of the stores is to be retarded or deferred.

iii) **FACILITIES FOR TEST AND EXAMINATION:**

- a) The supplier shall at his own expenses afford the Inspector all reasonable accommodation (warehouse) and facilities for satisfying himself that stores are being or have been manufactured in accordance with the particulars and for this purpose the Inspector shall have full and free access at any time during the contract to the supplier works and may not withstanding any contractual terms to the contrary require the supplier to make arrangements for the store or any part thereof to be inspected at the suppliers premises or at any other place and the supplier shall reserve a similar rights as regards any sub-contract he may makè.
- b) The supplier shall pay all costs connected with such tests and provide without extra charge, all materials tools labor and assistance or every kind which the Inspectors may consider necessary for any test and examination other than special –independent test which he shall require to be made on the suppliers premises for making the tests the supplier shall bear the cost of carrying out such test elsewhere.
- c) The supplier shall also provide and deliver free of charge at each place as the Inspector may direct such materials as he may require for test by chemical or other analysis or intended testing machines or means commonly in use according to the nature of the stores. In the event of such tests being unsatisfactory and resulting in leading to the rejection of the stores concerned the cost of the tests will be borne the supplier. Such cost will be assessed at the rates charged by the laboratory-testing firm concerned for work for private firm and individuals.

iv) **POWER OF THE INSPECTOR:**

The authority to certify performance; The Inspector shall have power before any stores or parts thereof are submitted for inspection to certify that they cannot be in accordance with the contract owing to the method of manufacture not being satisfactory or to reject any stores submitted as not being in accordance with the particulars.

v) **REJECTION**

- a) The Inspector may reject the whole consignment Tendered for inspection if after inspection of such portion thereof as he may decide at his discretion he is such satisfied that the consignment is not up to the specification.
- b) If any store is rejected as aforesaid then to allow the contractor to re-submit stores in replacement and the contractor will bear all costs on such replacement without being entitled to any extra payment without prejudice .
- c) If there is any discrepancy between drawn sample and final delivery goods than, Seller will be responsible for such discrepancy and Buyer shall have right to terminate the contract and/or claim compensation in addition to the forfeiture of Performance Security and/or legal action will be taken against seller.

vi) **MARKING OF REJECTIONS:**

If considered desirable by the Inspector, rejected stores will be marked with small rejection marks, so that these may be easily identified if resubmitted and the contractor shall not be entitled to claim anything on that account.

- f) If for any reason, Pre-shipment Inspection report is found not conforming to the ordered specification, TCB shall reserve the right to ask for compensation determined by TCB and/or double inspection fee and/or fruitless journey fee and/or any legal action taken by TCB.

The appointed Pre-shipment Inspection Agent shall not disagree/refuse/express their inability to carry out Pre-shipment Inspection of (Corporation/Enterprise/Projects) goods to be imported by the buyer in any country/place/port of the world.

12.0. **POST LANDING INSPECTION:**
